St. Joseph's Guild – Meets on 1st Tuesday at 7PM, All gentlemen over 18 are encouraged and expected to attend.

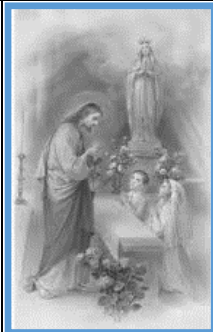
Little Flowers Girls' Group –Meets 1st and 3rd Saturdays, 10AM-11:30AM. Ages 4-12 are welcome.

Legion of Mary – Meets Tuesdays 7PM.

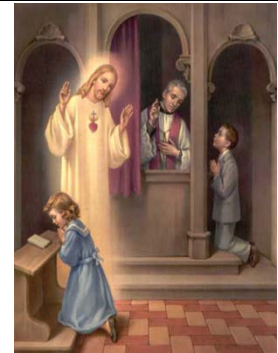
