Catholic Charities is Seeking Companion Care Workers for Seniors

CCEVA is hiring several Companion Care workers to provide companionship to clients enrolled in the Companion Care Pilot Program in order for them to stay socially engaged and to provide assistance with their daily activities so that they can remain in their home comfortably and safely. The program provides non-medical, in-home support services such as home management (light housekeeping, laundry, bed making, and trash removal), meal planning and preparation, grocery shopping and running errands for client, transporting clients in your car to run errands and shopping, and providing medication reminders. This is considered a contracted position, part-time with flexible schedules. Successful applicants will have two or more years of recent experience in caring for the elderly. Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) or have successfully completed a Home Care Training Program is preferred. Applicants must complete a 25-hour training course.
