**Faithful Citizenship.** On the third of November this year, there will be a national election to elect/reelect members of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives. In 2015 the US Conference of Catholic Bishops approved and published the document *Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship* to help Catholics form their consciences in accordance with the truth, so that they could make good moral choices. The bishops do not tell Catholics how to vote, that responsibility rests with each person and his or her properly formed conscience, and the USCCB publication is provided to help them form their conscience. A summary of the bishop's document is posted in the narthex.
