CCEVA is hiring several Companion Care workers to provide companionship to clients enrolled in the Companion Care Pilot Program in order for them to stay socially engaged and to provide assistance with their daily activities in order to remain in their home comfortably and safely. The Companion Care Program provides non-medical, in-home support services such as: home management (light housekeeping, laundry, bed making, and trash removal), meal planning and preparation, grocery shopping and running errands for client, transporting clients in your car to run errands and shopping, and providing medication reminders. In-Home Respite Care

Applications are now being taken for In-Home Respite Care Workers ages 18 through retirement years. After completing a 25-hour free training program, the workers will be given assignments to work in 3- to 8-hour increments in various households in the Hampton Roads area. The position provides companionship for an elderly individual being cared for in the home, ensuring their safety. No transporting, cleaning or heavy lifting is required.
