St. Anne's Sodality– Meets on 1st Tuesday at 6 PM, All ladies 18yrs and older are welcome.

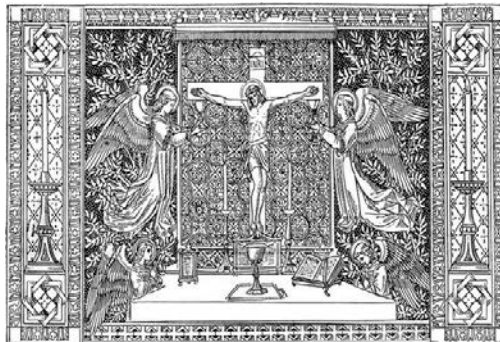
St. Anne's Sewing Guild – Meets the 2nd Saturday of the month from 10AM -3PM

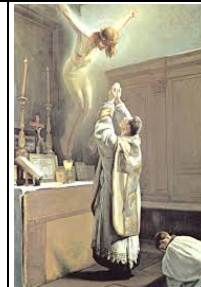
