The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls. On all the days from November 1 through November 8 inclusive, a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the Poor Souls, is granted to those who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed.

All Souls Day Novena

Envelopes will be available in the narthex next week for inscribing the names of your departed loved ones. The envelopes will be placed next to the tabernacle during the novena (Nov. 1-8) so the people listed will be especially remembered at all Holy Masses. It is a sacred tradition, nay, obligation, to pray for the dead.
